



"Lord, I fix my thoughts on You and Your goodness today. I will think truth and walk in Your peace. I rest in You. In Jesus' name, Amen."






"Father, I thank You that You have good plans and good thoughts towards me. I am not a mistake or a failure, and I am moving forward in my future with You.

You never fail us or abandon us. We silence every voice and lie that is contrary to Your Word. In Jesus' name, Amen."


